SAN MARINO: IT WILL BE UP TO THE GOVERNMENT TO INVOLVE THE UN ON UFOS

On the evening of Thursday 19 the Great and General Council, the San Marino Parliament, discussed and voted on the "Istance of Arengo" (a request addressed to the Captains Regent on the basis of an ancient popular initiative law) jointly proposed by the Italian National UFO Center (CUN) and the International Coalition for Extraterrestrial Research (ICER), institutions both directed by the aerospace journalist Dr. Roberto Pinotti, who for three decades has successfully coordinated the annual UFO World Symposium under the aegis of the Government.

Given the blatant recognition of the reality of UFOs indicated by the Pentagon since 2021 as "an objective, intelligent, technologically advanced reality of unknown origin", this Instance devoted to the so-called "Project Titan" provides for San Marino to ask the UN to create an Office intended to organize a conference that periodically takes stock of the studies of the UFO phenomenon at an international level, to be kept under the aegis of the United Nations in the territory. And this in the light of the traditional Symposium organized by the Italian CUN (a body created in 1967) today supported by the ICER, a Non-Governmental Organization born in 2021 and made up of experts from over 30 countries on 5 continents.

The Secretary of State for Tourism Federico Pedini Amati defined it as a very interesting project, and specified that the Government's indication is favorable, underlining the media, tourist and commercial advantages deriving from the initiative. Interest and curiosity dominated the interventions, and the Instance - whose text, edited with Pinotti by Paolo Guizzardi, already working at the Italian Embassy in Berlin - was approved by a majority. The Government of San Marino has therefore formally received a mandate to proceed and therefore the initiative opens up new, unsuspected and more important scenarios than one might think.

As the US-Israeli scientist Avi Loeb of Harvard University recently declared, if we are really faced with extraterrestrial spaceships, all of this certainly cannot affect the various countries individually that have been dealing with the issue institutionally for some time, but the whole humanity, represented by the United Nations.
